Magnet School Decisions -

All applicants will receive email notifications of their admissions status from BCPS Magnet Programs. Magnet admission decisions for high school applicants will be released by March 8, 2024 (date subject to change). Parents must accept or decline seat offer **electronically** by the identified deadline or the offer will be revoked. Once initial seat offers have been accepted or declined, available seats will be offered to students on the program's waitlist. Parents receiving placement offers from the waitlist have three (3) business days to respond. Failure to respond will result in forfeiture of the seat, and the placement will be offered to the next student on the waitlist.
