Supply List for 2009-2010

Supplies for School Use:

- ❑ Pens – blue or black and red
- ❑ Pencils – at least one dozen #2 pencils
- ❑ One large, hard-covered 3-ring binder or two 2-inch binders (one for the morning, one for afternoon)
- ❑ Pencil case or pouch for each binder/notebook to keep your supplies organized.
- ❑ Notebook paper – one large pack, **wide ruled** – not college ruled
- ❑ Dividers – 2 packs of 8 dividers (16 total tabs)
- ❑ Colored pencils
- ❑ Highlighters at least 2 different colors, one should be yellow
- ❑ 4 AAA batteries (for calculators)
- ❑ Sketchbooks, SPIRAL BOUND ONLY, no glued pages, *available at CMS bookstore or art rooms for \$5.00*
- ❑ **6th Grade:** One spiral notebook with a pocket for math
- ❑ **Tech Ed:** One 2-pocket folder, transparent and/or metal Ruler – metric and standard measurement, pencils, large pencil case to carry project materials, optional: safety glasses/goggles must comply with ANSI Z87.1 (available at CMS for \$5.00), optional: basic function calculator for 7th and 8th grades.
- ❑ **World Music or American Music:** One 1-inch binder to be kept in the music classroom throughout the year.
- ❑ **Chorus:** One 2-pocket folder

Supplies for Home Use:

- ❑ Ruler – metric and standard measurement
- ❑ One protractor and compass
- ❑ One calculator (A graphing calculator is recommended for Algebra I and II students.)
- ❑ Graph paper for Algebra I or II
- ❑ One dictionary

Recommended but Not Required:

- ❑ A flash drive to store computer files
- ❑ Eraser, one large
- ❑ One three hole punch to keep in binder
